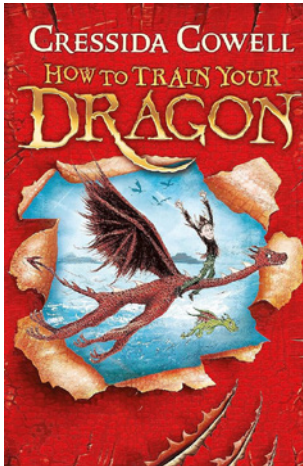
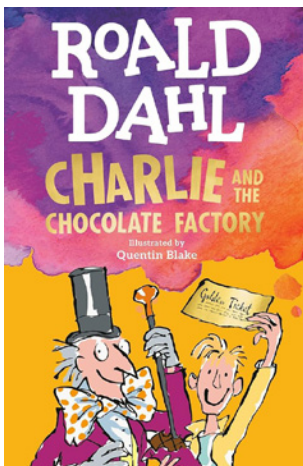

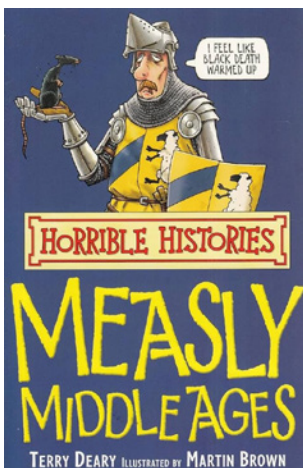
Cressida Cowell – How to Train Your Dragon

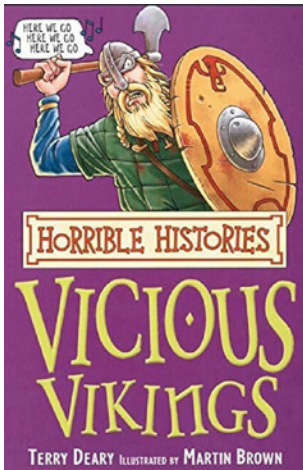
Roald Dahl – Charlie and the Chocolate Factory

Immerse yourself in Willy Wonka's magical chocolate factory as Charlie Bucket and a group of golden ticket winners experience sweet wonders and moral lessons.



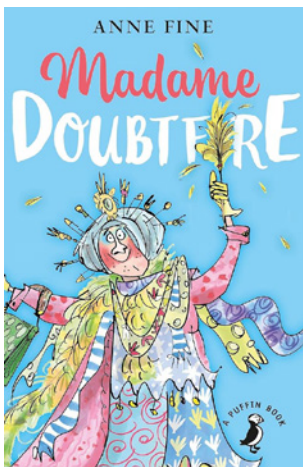
Terry Deary – The Measly Middle Ages

Delve into the humorous and often grim historical facts of the Middle Ages in this entertaining installment of the Horrible Histories series.



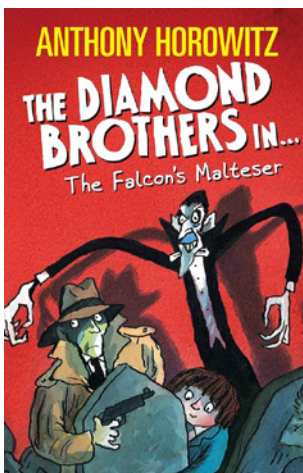
Terry Deary – The Vicious Vikings

In this heartwarming and comedic tale, the eccentric Euphegenia Doubtfire disguises herself as a nanny to remain close to her children after a divorce.



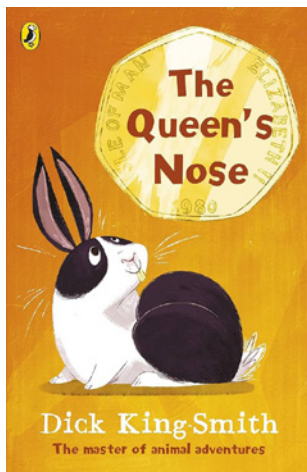
Anthony Horowitz – The Falcon's Malteser

Join the bumbling Tim Diamond and his younger brother Nick as they stumble into a web of mystery, crime, and hilarity in this detective adventure.



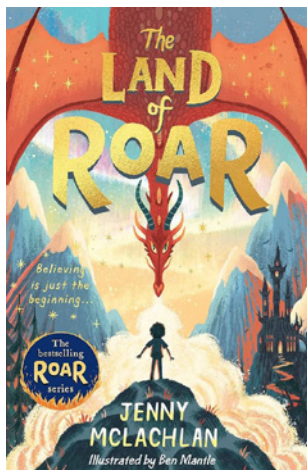
Tove Jansson – Finn Family Moomintroll

Moomintroll, Sniff and Snufkin discover the Hobgoblin's top hat on a mountain-top, unaware of its strange powers...



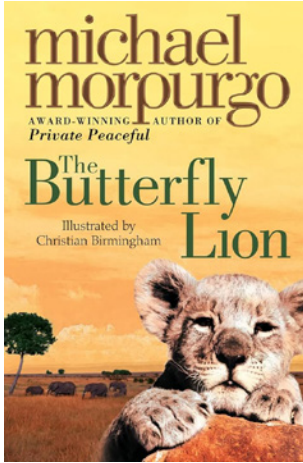
Dick King Smith – The Queen's Nose

Follow the enchanting story of Harmony, who discovers a magical 50-pence coin that grants wishes but comes with unexpected consequences.



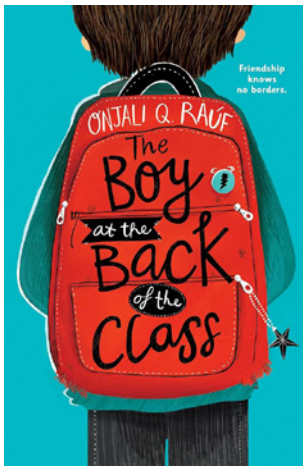
Jenny McLachlan – The Land of Roar

Twins Arthur and Rose find themselves transported to the fantastical Land of Roar, where they must confront their fears and save this imaginative world from destruction.



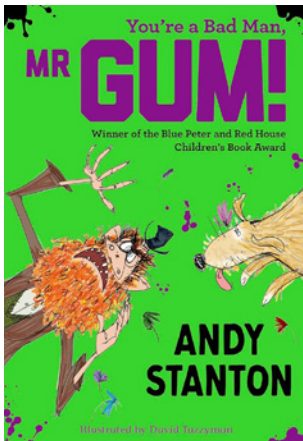
