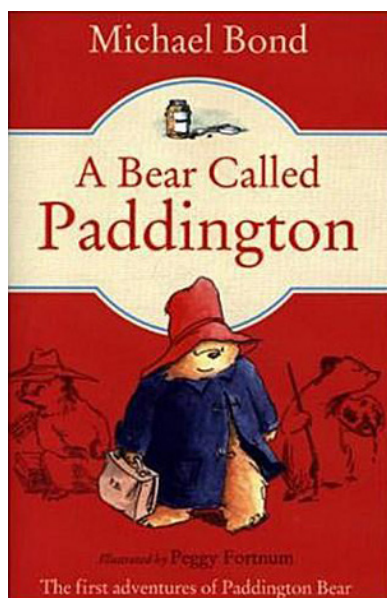




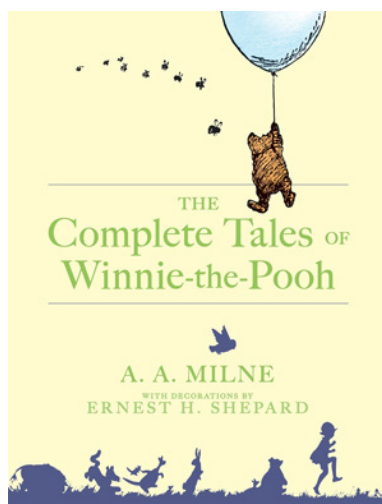

Books to cherish with boys age 4 – 8



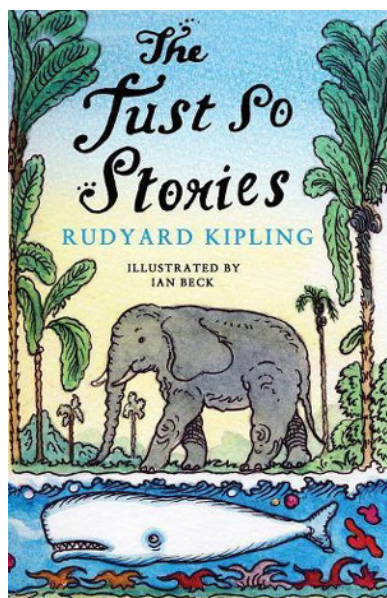
Reception (Age 4-5)

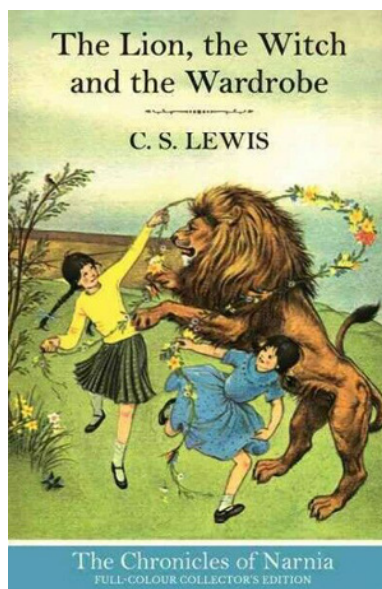
Year 1 (Age 5-6)
